## **Waste Collection**

90,460 pounds (45 tons) of hazardous materials were collected throughout the 2010 Adams County Household Chemical Roundups. This waste total includes:

- 5,890 pounds of flammable materials
- 61,800 pounds of paint
- 1,233 gallons of motor oil
- 5,448 pounds of pesticides
- 1,600 pounds of aerosol cans
- 263 gallons of acids and bases
- 362 gallons of antifreeze
- 225 pounds of devices containing mercury

This figure does not include 211 tires, 231 gas cylinders, 147 automotive batteries, and 21,177 pounds of electronic waste.

## **Waste Collection**

292,856 pounds (146 tons) of hazardous materials were collected throughout the 2010 Douglas County Household Chemical Roundups. This waste total includes:

- 19,865 pounds of flammable materials
- 201,200 pounds of paint
- 3,052 gallons of motor oil
- 17,571 pounds of pesticides
- 4,725 pounds of aerosol cans
- 2,043 gallons of acids and bases
- 930 gallons of antifreeze
- 570 pounds of devices containing mercury

This figure does not include 552 tires, 849 gas cylinders, and 491 automotive batteries.
