Certified Pool Operator Course

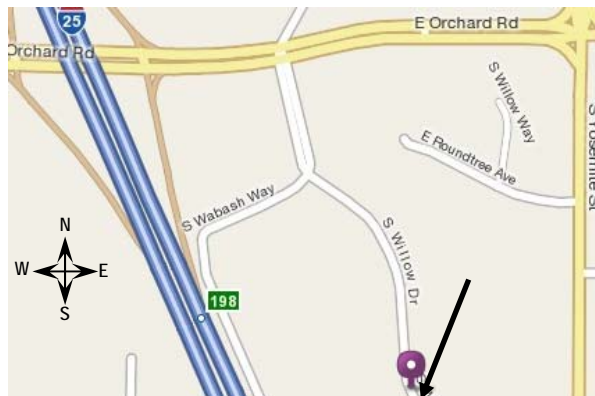
