We can help you choose the best birth control method for you. We recommend that you have a regular doctor (primary care provider) to take care of all your other health care needs. We have a current list of low-cost primary care providers in your area.

Our family planning clinics are staffed by consulting Physicians, Nurse Practitioners and Certified Nurse Midwives who have the advanced training necessary to meet the varying needs of our clients.

## Family Planning Services

- Birth control supplies and condoms
- Emergency contraception (Plan B)
- Pelvic exams
- Pap tests
- Breast exams
- Pregnancy tests and counseling for pregnancy options
- Treatment for vaginal infections
- Testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STI)
- Educational materials

## Fees for Services

Fees for birth control services and supplies are on a sliding scale according to income level. We are able to offer low cost birth control services because they are subsidized by the federal government.

## Other Services and Fees

Additional services are offered to clients who currently receive birth control care at Tri-County Health Department.

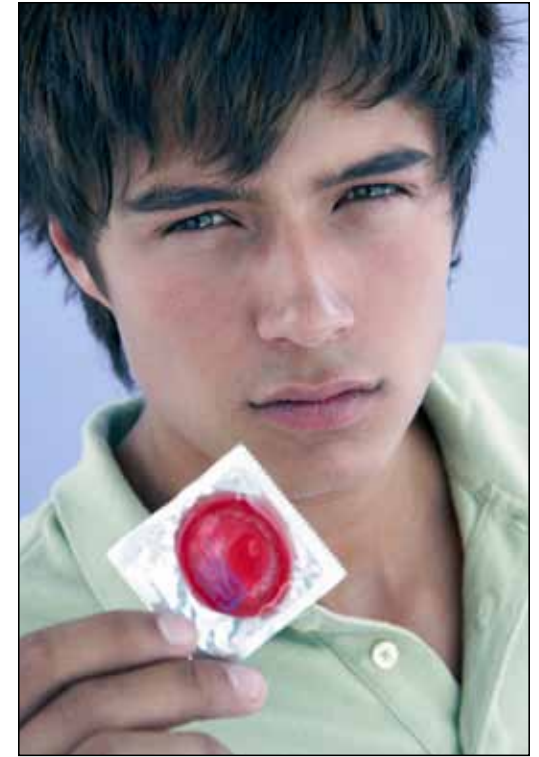
Fees for services that are not related to birth control have a set fee, and must be paid at time of service. These include:

- Repeat Pap tests
- Some Laboratory tests
- Sexually Transmitted Infection screening and infection treatments
- HIV/AIDS screening
- Special procedures such as colposcopy and LEEP
