



Application for Project/Practicum for MPH Students

Thank you for considering Tri-County Health Department as your MPH project/practicum site. The process for applying and being accepted for a practicum is competitive. In order to be considered for a project/practicum, you must submit the following at least 30 days prior to your requested start date:

- Resume with at least 2 professional/work (paid or unpaid) references
- Cover Letter that includes:
 - Which available Tri-County Project/Practicum experience is preferred (please choose from those posted on our website)
 - Why you have chosen the specific project/practicum experience
 - What you hope to gain from the experience
 - What you are able to contribute to the project/practicum
 - Include your long and short term career goals and how the project/practicum experience will help reach those goals
 - Include the timeframe you prefer to work on the project/practicum
 - Cover Letter must be limited to one page, with minimum font size of 10 pt.
- Current transcript from your Accredited School of Public Health (for more information about which schools are accredited in public health, please visit the Council on Education for Public Health at <http://www.ceph.org/i4a/pages/index.cfm?pageid=1>)
